- Produced a profit and loss statement for Julian- sent the changes to see if that would work. Conversation about reports from the treasurer. The yearly statement will come from Lisa. Because she is a non-profit, she would have to pull this together.
- John Black said he stopped working on everything, but he has not worked on that at all.
- Received the first set of ledger financials (didn't know that was available) off by 3.66 for a technology charge.
- Not sure how we will be set up which caused the delay. All the invoices were paid on the 15th.
- Also have ~36,390 for the charter. Not sure how to get that money in the bank.
 - i. Also received a 590\$ payment
- Sent an email to commerce to see if they could take an ACH payment.
 - Must be set up (Cheryl has provided all the information) need to work out the details.
- If we don't receive the funds how to we escalate that process? We do not have a clear direction on how to collect outstanding funds.
 - i. When we get the RFP it will be important to understand how that process works
 - ii. Come Jan 1 we will be sending a new round of billing- do we add the invoicing.
 - 1. We cannot bill more than 200,000 a year- we can have more than 200,000 in our account
 - a. May have to take a vote and figure out how much we are going to apportion
 - 2. Not sure what will be paid to the intern, commerce, Juliane
 - 3. State Collections will send out a collection letter, but they cannot collect.
 - 4. Need to provide a list for each of the companies that has not paid. Juliane will call them we can revisit giving a letter to the state.
- The fine is sent by the utilities commission, funds go to the education commission- do we need to track this

RFP-

- John Black told Lisa that an external contractor cannot leverage the team's site.
 - This will not work for the admin we just brought on
 - Is there a policy or reason outside contractors could not leverage teams?
- Couple of folks interested but have not received information on who has submitted.
 - Compiled the answers so the RFP questions and answers are posted.
 - Those are being posted today because of the need of the financial documents that were needed.
- New letter to go out to the unresponsive to explain again and then ask for payment.
 - Questions about this letter being real. How the calculation was derived. Need to make sure that companies understand this is a requirement.
- With the amount we have in we have enough to pay the legal and commerce bills. Follow up on how the payment piece works.
 - Said these two would be the first two that would be sent and processed.
 - Legal will send out an invoice.

- Juliane Comment- update on where we are with the process.
 - Answers were posted today- sent the final product that was posted.
 - It will close on Nov 2nd 3pm. Hopefully we will get several submissions.
 - Talked to several other boards or lawyers and they have gotten several submissions.
 - Contract start date effective date is set to be Dec 1st
 - Juliane will provide link to those locations.

Utilities commission

- Tracking sheet showing how the cases are progressing. Using to track case number-initial ruling- who the training needs to be conducted by. And then who we are going to file the docket under. When sent for docket information put the number and send the letter saying here are the findings and file electronically and put the date.
 - There was a case that the addresses were bad and none of the letters had made it. If these do not make it to them and the commission does not submit any information. Do we keep it or move to another group?
 - Louis- in the process there is a flow chart- if we say it goes back to the company and ask for the company to provide a name- company would provide who was appropriate. Provide a list of contact names. Looking at this more electronically down the road.
 - 1. Who is going to go back to the company and ask a name? Do we need a form letter to amend?
 - We need or have a point person for the company to ask who should be applied
 - ii. Make a Motion- add a process that would include a process adjustment to add a letter when there is a violation for the company to define who should take the training in the case of a violation. Amend the Motion to say that if there is not a response to the letter, we will use the name registered with the SOS
 - 1. Discussion- reach out to the utilities to find out who the contact person needs to be.
 - a. This may be incomplete list there would be a draft letter at the beginning of each year when collecting the POC for the company.
 - b. If you do not provide a name, we will use the registered person with the SOS office.
 - c. Can we get an exported DB of the list of companies and the POC-?
 - 2. Any opposed? (no responses) Motion Carries.
 - 3. Need a place to track the names of who initial contacts are with each of the companies. When the process comes back for the team to approve this will be part of the process.
 - If we want the supervisor to take and do not specify an individual- commission will not do anything until they tell us an individual's name.
 - i. Need to get an individual's name
 - ii. Need to send a letter and they would have to formally respond, or they will close with no action.
